Concurrent Technologies Corporation Receives Pro Patria Award, the Highest State-Level Honor Given to a Civilian Employer by the U.S. Department of Defense

Johnstown, PA, June 24, 2008—Daniel R. CTC is also a nominee for the "Employer Support Freedom" award, the ESGR's most prestigious level of national recognition. The Freedom Award is presented annually by the Secretary of Defense to the nation's most supportive employers. The Secretary recognizes up to five employers annually with this award at ceremonies held at the Pentagon in Washington, DC.

Congressman John P. Murtha (D-PA 12) commented on the Pro Patria Award, "CTC goes above and beyond to support employees who are volunteering to safeguard our national security. The company is known for its efforts to provide family support, job security, and continuing benefits to those who serve."
