### **Concurrent Technologies Corporation Makes "Best Places to Work in PA" List for Eighth Consecutive Year**

**Johnstown, PA, December 11, 2008** – For the eighth consecutive year, Concurrent Technologies Corporation (CTC) has been named as one of the "100 Best Places to Work in Pennsylvania."
