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**Concurrent Technologies Corporation Awarded Subcontract to Support
Development of Ammunition Demilitarization Software Package**

CTC will also prepare a cost estimate for the development and testing of new or modified software, including integration into an existing Army network Enterprise Resource Planning program.

The task of decreasing the military’s munitions stockpile is enormous, and CTC’s work in this process will help determine how to best demilitarize this conventional ammunition in the most efficient way possible,” said Edward J.
