James S. Cogswell Award Presented to Only 36 of 13,500 Cleared Facilities

Facilities are eligible only if they achieve a minimum of two consecutive “Superior” industrial security review ratings and show a sustained degree of excellence and innovation in their overall security program management, implementation, and oversight.
